(Boston) Celebrity Series of Boston will present pianist **Lise de la Salle in recital** on Saturday, January 28 at 8pm at NEC's Jordan Hall, 30 Gainsborough Street, Boston. This is an Aaron Richmond Recital.

This is Lise de la Salle's **Celebrity Series of Boston** debut.

Pianist Lise de la Salle was born in 1988 in Cherbourg, and gave her first concert at the age of 9 at Radio France. She graduated in 2001 from the Conservatoire Supérieur-CNR de Paris with the Premier Prix in Pierre Reach's class. In September 2003 Ms. de la Salle was admitted to the postgraduate cycle of Bruno Rigutto at the Conservatoire National Supérieur de Musique de Paris. Since 2001 she has performed throughout Europe, America and Japan, and has also participated in several European festivals, including performances as a soloist with the Festival de la Roque d'Anthéron, the Bad Kissingen Festival, the Schleswig-Holstein Music Festival, the George Enesco Festival in Bucarest and the Festival de Saint Denis. Her first recording was of works by Ravel and Rachmaninov with the label Naïve Classique, and her second recording was of works by Bach and Liszt, which was selected as the Gramophone Recording of the Month in August 2005.

Lise de la Salle has performed with many orchestras worldwide, including the Gulbenkian Orchestra, the Schleswig Holstein Orchestra, the WDR Sinfonieorchester Cologne, the Ensemble Orchestral de Paris, the Staatskapelle Weimar, the Belgian National Orchestra, the Orchestre National de Lyon, the Kanazawa Ensemble, the Württembergisches Kammerorchester Heilbronn, the Saint Petersburg Symphonic, the Pasadena Symphonic Orchestra as well as the Deutsches Symphonieorchester. She has also worked with many conductors including Lawrence Foster, Jun Märkl, Moshe Atzmon, Arie Van Beck, Alexander Dmitriev, Jaja Ling, Semyon Bychkov, James Gaffigan and Keith Lockhart.

In 2007, Ms. de la Salle released “Concertos No.1” (Shostakovich, Liszt, Prokofiev) with Maestro Lawrence Foster and the Gulbenkian Orchestra, as well as a double CD dedicated to Mozart and Prokofiev. Most recently, she released her album *Chopin: Four Ballades, Piano concerto no. 2* in 2010.
